Big Idea: To discover helpful insights about Habakkuk’s prayer adventure that can help us connect with God.

Getting in STEP with Habakkuk . . .

Identify Your Rampart

Invite God to reveal to you a place where you can wait on Him to speak to you.

I. The Silence of God – The Wait

- How long? – verse 1:2
- Waiting on the rampart. – verse 2:1

II. The Theodicy of God – The Complexity

- ‘Theo’ – God; ‘dike’ – order, right or righteousness – v 1:12-13
- Definition – the defense of God’s goodness and justice in the face of the existence of evil.
- God is concerned more about your holiness than your happiness.

III. The Embracer of God – The Name

- Habakkuk is burdened by what burdens God – v 1:1
- God embraces those who embrace Him.

IV. The Promise of God – The Hope

- “I am doing something in your days. . .” – v 1:5
- “For the vision is yet for the appointed time; . . . though it tarries, wait for it;” – v 2:3
- “But the righteous will live by faith.” – v 2:4
